## Framing Service Measuring Guide

Please use these instructions to accurately measure your Chura and Kaleera for our framing services. It is really important that you use a standard ruler and take measurements in cm to the nearest mm . These measurements will be used to ensure the mounting board for your design is suitable and offers a perfect fit.

## Measuring your Chura

Place your Chura vertically on a flat surface and ensure they are tightly aligned and in order. Take a ruler and measure the height of the Chura from the outer tips on both sides in cm to the nearest mm as shown in Fig 1.
Chura Height $(\mathrm{H} 1): \mathrm{cm} \mathrm{mm}$

Next, take the largest size single bangle from your Chura and place this flat down on a flat surface. Take a ruler and measure the diameter of the bangle from the outer tips on both sides in cm to the nearest mm as shown in Fig 2.

## Measuring your Kaleera

Hang your Kaleera vertically and let it drop down freely. Take a ruler and measure the height of the Kaleera from the top of the Kaleera (excluding the string/chain) to the lowest point in cm to the nearest mm as shown in Fig 3.

Kaleera Height (H2):


Take a ruler and measure the widest point of the Kaleera from the outer tips on both sides in cm to the nearest mm as shown in Fig 3.
